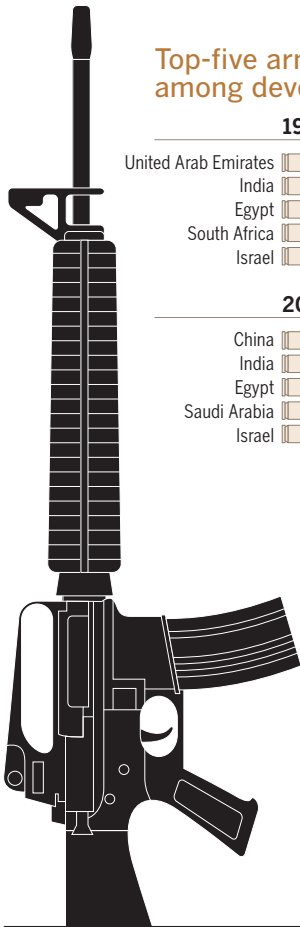


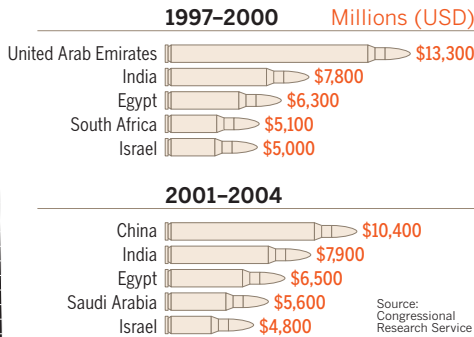
# Under the Radar

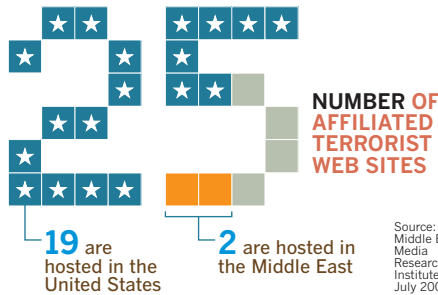
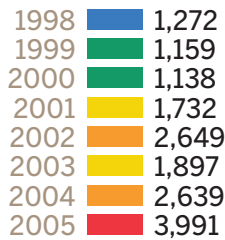


## Top-five arms purchasers among developing nations:

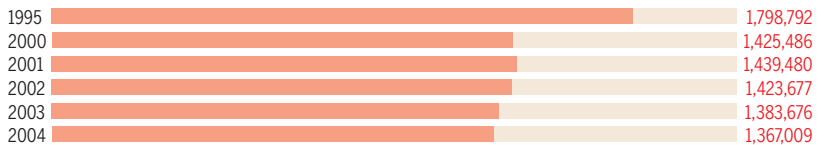
Estimated increase in surveillance cameras in New York, 2000 to 2005:

**300% to 500%**

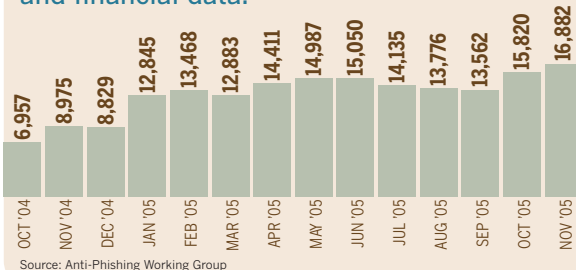
